## *From our Pastor....*

Summer is nearly upon us. I know what that means. It means kids riding bikes, vacations, trips to the lake, getting too hot, sleeping in, and roller coaster rides (well and hundreds of other fun things). But it also means deaths from long heat spells, West Nile virus, poison ivy, and bike wrecks.

That's just how life is. Most of what we experience in life has some mix of good and bad. Nearly everything that we do has the potential to both renew us and damage us. And sometimes the things that we think we need in order to relax and have fun, won't actually give us either.

That's why we all need to be sure that when we talk about summer with its vacations and good times we don't mean a vacation from God. We need God. We may think that it is all right for us to sleep in and skip Sunday worship or that we can learn everything we need to know about the Lord in the nine months of the Sunday School year, but to actually believe that we would have to believe that nothing bad could happen to us in the summer or that we will not be challenged by hard decisions as long as the sun is high in the sky or that Bermuda shorts and temptation cannot intermingle.

Understand that I am not being tough on you. I love to have fun and to take vacations myself. I really enjoy getting out to a campground without a phone so that I can relax. It's just that I love you. And because I love you and because I know that life goes on with all of its ache and yearning no matter what the climate, I want to

remind you to stay close to God this summer.

I remember Derek. He was a very tall and athletic thirteen year old. He looked beautiful and totally normal that summer evening at Children's hospital. He had had a wonderful day of swimming with friends. There was no alcohol or drugs at the party. No negligence, no horsing around. It's just that no one noticed that Derek went under in the deep end of the pool and didn't come up again.

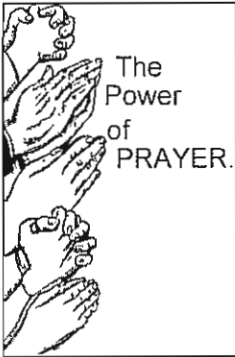
When the Doctor told his mother that Derek was dead she didn't say a word. She didn't make a sound. She just fainted right into my arms. If you could talk to her, even now, she would tell you of her need for God.

Don't allow yourself to get away from God! Not even for a minute. If you can't be in worship here, go somewhere. If you are on the beach and cannot find a church to attend, stop and pray for an hour. Take your Bible with you on vacation and make time to read and study and do devotions; your soul needs renewal every bit as much as your body and mind.

Have a wonderful time this summer but have it *with* God. Sure enough, you need God just as much now as at any other time of your life. And besides, God never takes a vacation from you.

**PRAYING BY THE BOOK....  
Using Scripture in Prayer**

It is human nature to feel strongly about our convictions and this same mindset carries over into our prayers. Through prayer, we approach God for his help to do what we as humans within our limited ability cannot. Our hope is that God, in his mighty power & unparalleled mercy, will bring about the desired outcome.....but the question is, whose desired outcome? How can we pray with total conviction, YOUR WILL BE DONE? And how do we discover God’s will?

Songwriter/musician, Carol Owens, and co-author of over 250 worship songs with her husband, Jimmy, tells us that we can find the answer to these questions by searching God’s Word. She writes\*:


*The Scriptures teach me how to pray God’s will. To receive answers to my specific prayer concerns, I must first be certain not to request things that aren’t part of his destiny for me. Though it isn’t always easy, I must honestly submit my will to him and wait patiently to hear his answer above all the clamor of my own desires.*

I find God most clearly---and pray more effectively---when searching the Bible to find out what *HE* thinks about things. When I can pray back his own words to him, I know I am praying in

agreement with God. Then I can claim the promise of 1 John 5:14-15 (see above). Scripture is the key to answered prayer.

How different our prayers might be if we begin by *searching God’s Word &* praying not only for his divine intervention, but also for *HIS WILL* to be done in our lives and the lives of others!!!

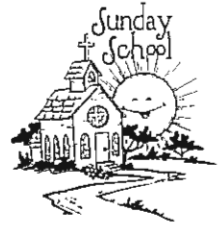

### New Member Sponsors:

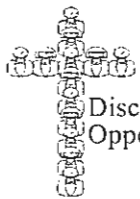

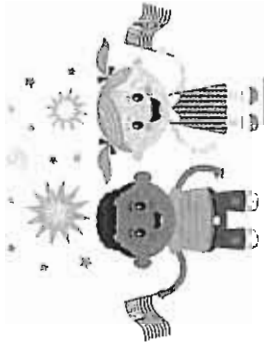

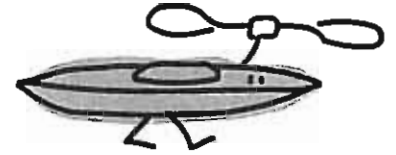
